#### DC WATER

**Northeast Boundary Tunnel (NEBT) Project updated completion dates for the area construction sites.** Fall 2020-First Street Pumping Station construction site: Demobilization on point will be underground. #### DDOT

Kelly Jeong-Olson states that DDOT's Vision Zero team is aware of the community's concerns along N. Capitol corridor and the improvements are already in the works. Also, she shares that North Capitol will be included in their High Injury Network (HIN), which will be published as part of the Vision Zero Action Plan 2.0. This means that DDOT will be looking at additional proactive safety measures, such as installation of high-visibility markings, Leading Pedestrian Interval (LPIs), left-turn traffic calming, and prohibition of right turn on red. DDOT will also be considering the HIN for upcoming capital projects, likely giving priority to safety projects on roadways designated as part of the HIN.

For the past few months, DDOT has done the following along the N Capitol between Michigan and NY Ave: upgraded all of the crosswalks with high visibility markings; added "pedestrian crossing" signs; added "25 mph" speed limit signs along the corridor

DDOT is also looking at other safety measures, such as driver feedback signs, HAWK signal, and/or Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB). Ms Jeong-Olson, the Community Engagement Specialist-Ward 5, states that she will keep the community updated.

#### DPW

##### **New Yard Waste Program Changes**

Starting on May 4<sup>th</sup>, you must make a request to schedule yard waste pickup: Yard Wastes will only be pickup in an appropriate purchased yard waste bags.

There are three big changes to the program:

1. By appointment: Call 311; Use 311 online; or DPW App
2. No more than 20 or fewer bags a one pickup (changed from 5 or fewer bags)
3. Do not place yard waste in regular trash: Leave, grass, weeds, bundle branches, pinecone, uprooted plants, etc.
