NEIGHBORHOOD ISSUES

Rodents, Overgrowth, Graffiti, Vacancies, Traffic Calming

A Rodent Abatement Meeting was scheduled on Tuesday, July 21st with Gerald Brown, a rep from DOH for Stronghold Neighborhood to conduct a Walk Thru. A second meeting was scheduled with Mr. Brown on July 30th for Northern Bloomingdale Neighborhood.

Along with the DOH rep, DPW rep, Lisa Douglas was present thru out the Walk Thru. Ms. Douglas noted that trash cans with holes made by rodents in them may be replaced; and for the cans with missing lids, these cans may be repaired by calling 311 or by using 311.dc.gov online. Must provide the number on the can for service.

Walk Thru Findings: The DOH Rep pointed out that overgrowth of grass and weeds would have to be taken care of prior to requested Rodent Abatement Treatment thru out the neighborhood.

With the noted findings, DCRA confirmed a walk thru. Mark-Anthony Tynes is the new DCRA Account Manager/Community Outreach Specialist/ Liaison for Ward 5. He noted Stronghold issues and submitted 311 Service Requests to address them. Another walk thru is scheduled on Wednesday, Sept 16th.

Regarding the alley and sidewalk repairs, I've submitted 311 Service Request. Many 311 Service Requests will not be address until 2021.

With persistence, DPR has addressed the missing tennis court net @ the **Edgewood Recreation Center**.
